OUR MESSAGE TODAY IS GIVEN BY MEGHANN COTTER

Meghann grew up in Spotsylvania, VA. And is a member of FUMC. She is married to her husband, Brad, of five years. They have a 2-year-old son, Patrick. Her interest in building a better community began at an early age. At five, Meghann joined her parents in serving meals to community homeless staying in a shelter that rotated between area churches. As a teenager, she went with our youth group to a work camp that helped fix homes of low-income people in Petersburg, VA. On the way home, Meghann asked her youth leader why the group had to go so far away to help people in need, when there were surely people in need of their help in Fredericksburg. Inspired by the question, the youth leader worked with Meghann and many other parent leaders to develop a similar housing restoration project that is today known as FRED Camp. Meghann graduated from Emory & Henry College in 2004 with a degree in Mass Communications and Public Policy & community Services. She spent her early career as a reporter for the Free Lance-Star, but kept finding herself called to make change in the community rather than write about those being driven by others. In 2005, many of the downtown church clergy came together to pool services and resources so that the street homeless had a better chance of having their needs met and improving their lives. They offered her the organization's lead position. Meghann always enjoys the opportunity to help new partners and volunteers find ways of using their gifts to care for the community's neighbors in need. She believes this work together is what will help bring an end to homelessness.
