## FOOD PANTRY FUND DRIVE

Last week-end, \$1,521 was received towards our goal of \$7,500! Many thanks to those who could respond so quickly. Remember, every dollar donated brings \$3 to the Food Pantry, thanks to the generosity of an anonymous donor.

Our Outreach Food Pantry Ministry has been serving the community for 25 years! The Pantry recently received an award for outstanding service. The award, from the Fredericksburg Area Regional Food Bank, recognizes the Pantry as the only area ministry that is open every Monday through Friday, and as a major supporter of the Bank. The Pantry spends over \$30,000 per year to obtain food and distribute it to those in need in our community.

The FUMC Food Pantry tries to provide enough food for several days to each family that applies for assistance. This year, through May, our volunteers distributed 11,000 pounds of groceries providing some 740 bags of food for 1,527 people.
