Micah Ministries is a faith-based organization that helps the Fredericksburg region's street homeless. The organization was founded in 2005 by downtown churches, which desired to create a community that loved its "least" through the call of Micah 6:8, doing justice, loving kindness and walking humbly with God. The founding congregations included Fredericksburg United Methodist Church. Today, its programs include a basic need and case management center, winter shelter, respite shelter for people leaving the hospital

with no home, as well as a housing and income development program.

By joining forces with partners, volunteers and generous donors, Micah forges relationships that help individuals move from basic survival to permanent housing. In the last six years, this approach has led to an 81% decline in the number of people sleeping on the street for a year or more. Many friends have helped us come this far, but we need even more to achieve our vision of ending local homelessness.

Micah is always looking for donations of basic survival items, such as socks and underwear, or common household goods, such as cleaning supplies or pots/pans. Donations can be delivered to Micah's hospitality center at 1013 Princess Anne St., Monday-Friday from 10am to 2pm. Our Outreach Food Pantry Ministry has been serving the community for 25 years! The Pantry recently received an award for outstanding service. The award, from the Fredericksburg Area Regional Food Bank, recognizes the Pantry as the only area ministry that is open every Monday through Friday, and as a major supporter of the Bank. The Pantry spends over \$30,000 per year to obtain food and distribute it to those in need in our community.

The FUMC Food Pantry tries to provide enough food for several days to each family that applies for assistance. This year, through May, our volunteers distributed 11,000 pounds of groceries providing some 740 bags of food for 1,527 people.
