2016 Annual Conference offering to support ministries in Cambodia, Brazil, Mozambique, Virginia.


Each year, members of local churches are encouraged to raise money for global mission projects designated by the bishop. Bishop Young Jin Cho recently announced that the special offering goal will be \$150,000 and again focus on both international and Virginia based mission needs.

Methodist Mission in Cambodia - \$50,000; Funds will support the training of lay and clergy leadership, purchase of property and construction of new church buildings.

Brazil Methodist church - \$25,000; The Shade and Fresh Water Project is keeping children off the streets by offering supervised activities and after-school programs for children between 6 and 14 years of age in cities and communities across Brazil.

United Methodist Church in Mozambique - \$25,000; your gift can help fund resources for training laity in two conference in that country.


